Tips for a Better Trip

- **Track bus location with our PassioGo App;** arrive at your bus stop at least five minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive and 30 minutes before class.
- **Wait for buses at designated stops;** stand on the sidewalk two to three feet from the curb.
- **Never chase a bus.** You may slip, fall or be struck by another vehicle. Use designated crosswalks and sidewalks to reach the bus stop. Never walk in a traffic lane.
- **Use caution** when walking alongside the bus or in areas when a bus is making a turn approaching your bus stop. You may see the bus, but the bus operator may not see you.

Transportation FAQs

How do I know if there is a delay or how can I track the location of the buses?



- Download the PassioGo app in the [Apple/Google Play](#) Store, and track your campus bus. Get real-time updates and up to the minute arrival information.

Do I have to pay a fare to ride a Rutgers University bus?

- Riding the Rutgers University buses is FREE on all campuses.

Do I need to show an ID to ride a Rutgers University bus?

- You do not have to show an ID on the New Brunswick and Camden campuses; you will be required to show ID on the Newark campus.

What if I lose an item on the bus?

- Items of value lost in a Rutgers University Bus are turned in to the campus-specific Rutgers Police Department (RUPD)

Does the university provide transportation among its Camden, Newark, and New Brunswick campuses?

- No, but the NJ Transit “Northeast Corridor” provides frequent service between the New Brunswick and Newark train stations. A transfer to the NJT River Line service at the Trenton train station connects Camden to the “Northeast Corridor” trains.

What is the The Knight Mover?

- The Knight Mover provides transportation within or among all the Rutgers University–New Brunswick & Piscataway Campuses after the Intercampus Transit System ceases to operate for the night.
- The Knight Mover service operates Monday – Thursday, 3am – 6am.
- You must show a valid university ID to the driver in order to board the Knight Mover shuttle.

Spring Semester permits go on sale in January.
