Rutgers-New Brunswick/Piscataway Intercampus Bus System: Big Chill 2022 Event Transit Alert

Saturday, December 3, 2022:

Due to the Big Chill event taking place, the "Weekend 1" and "Weekend 2" buses will operate on their regular Saturday schedules but will not be able to access various parts of the College Avenue Campus between the hours of 7AM to approximately 12PM. The Campus buses will not be able to service the following bus stops until the event is over:

College Avenue Student Center (7 AM to about 12 PM)

The Yard/Scott Hall (7 AM to about 12 PM)

The Student Activities Center (approximately 9:30 AM to about 12 PM).

During this time the Weekend Campus Buses operate on alternate routes. Starting at around 9:30 AM and lasting until about 12 PM (or earlier if all the roads in College Avenue Campus reopen) will pick up and drop off on Neilson Street by the Hyatt Regency Hotel in downtown New Brunswick (located at 2 Albany Street). This is an approximate 0.5 mile/10 minute walk from the Yard bus stop, a 0.8 mile/15 minute walk from the Student Activities Center, and a 1 mile/20 minute walk from the College Avenue Student Center.

Please refer to the map on the second page for the location of the Hyatt in relation to various locations throughout the College Avenue Campus.

In the northbound Neilson Street direction, the Weekend 1 buses will pick up on route from Douglass heading towards Busch; and the Weekend 2 buses will pick up on route from Douglass heading towards Livingston. In the southbound Neilson Street direction, the Weekend 1 buses will pick up on route from Livingston heading towards Douglass; and the Weekend 2 buses will pick up on route from Busch towards Douglass.

Passengers are advised to allow extra travel time when getting to the bus stop and travelling while the event is taking place/while the buses are on the detour routes. Passengers are also advised that prediction times generated by TransLoc may not be fully accurate at times due to the event and the nature of the detours involved. You are strongly advised to use the map feature on the TransLoc site/app to see exactly where the buses are/which direction they are presently travelling in.
