

The EPA/NJDEP have adopted new labeling requirements for hazardous waste containers effective May 30th, 2017.

In addition to the information previously required on the label, you must now indicate the hazard(s) associated with the waste (i.e. ignitable, corrosive, reactive, etc.)

To assist with this requirement, REHS has developed new labels that must be used on all hazardous waste containers, example below:
